COVID 19 ALTERNATE FEEDING PLAN

Dear Parents and Guardians,

In the event of a closure related to COVID-19, the Maryvale School District's Food & Nutrition Department will provide an opportunity for families to **drive up** and **pick-up** meals for children in their family at two sites. Meals will only be provided on days when students would otherwise have been in school.

Children do not need to be present in order for their meals to be provided. The student's identification number must be presented at pick up time in order to receive a meal.

The following sites will provide a lunch for that day and breakfast for the following day:

Primary School: Pick-up will be at the main entrance in front of the school.

Intermediate, Middle and High School: Pick-up will be at the front main Middle School door.

*Parents may select the site that is closest to their home.

*Alternate meals will be provided for students with dietary restrictions based on request during pick-up.

Meals will be served based on the student's last name as follows:

A-J - 10:30 - 11:30

K-T - 11:30 - 12:30

U-Z - 12:30 - 1:30

This program will be solely for the pick-up of meals that will not be consumed on site.

We encourage families to continue to be proactive in reducing the risk of COVID-19 by not congregating at the school site once meals have been distributed, continue to wash your hands often, sneeze or cough into a tissue and stay home if you are sick.
