Students may not start school until the Maryvale School District Student Registration Form is checked for completeness and the mandated residency, immunization, and birth date documentation have been presented.

**VERIFICATION OF BIRTH DATE**

- Birth Certificate
- Record of Baptism
- Official Driver's License
- Military ID
- State or other Government Issued ID
- School Photo w/DOB
- Consulate ID Card
- Hospital or Health Record
- Record from Non-Profit International Aid Agency
- Record from Non-Profit Volunteer Agency
- Native American Tribal Card
- Passport

**VERIFICATION OF RESIDENCY:**

- Lease/Rental Agreement (Must have landlord's signature) or  Mortgage
- Owners Affidavit w/ appropriate attachment (Mortgage Statement or Property Tax Statement)

**And one of the following:**

**\*Will be needed within 14 days of students first day of school if not provided at the time of registration**

- Auto Registration
- Insurance Bill
- Credit Card Billing Statement
- Property Tax Statement
- Photo ID Issued by a Government Agency
- W-2 Income Tax Form
- Utility bill (electric, gas or water)

**VERIFICATION OF IMMUNIZATION: Will be needed within 14 days of students 1<sup>st</sup> day of school if not provided at the time of registration**

Every student entering or attending public school must be immunized. Public school students must be immunized against poliomyelitis, mumps, measles, diphtheria, rubella, varicella, Haemophilus influenzae type B (Hib), pertussis, tetanus, pneumococcal disease, and hepatitis B.

No child may be admitted to school for more than 14 days without an appropriate immunization certificate or other acceptable evidence of immunization. The principal may extend this period to 30 days on a case-by-case basis when a student is transferred from another state or country.
